SPEAKING ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE

- ✓ The students come into the classroom one by one in the order they are listed.
- ✓ Each student has 3 minutes to prepare and is supposed to state his/her opinion in max. 4 minutes.
- ✓ Students have one question and one statement written on the page, and they are supposed to choose only one of them, either the question or the statement.
- ✓ Once a statement/question is chosen by a student, it cannot be changed.
- ✓ The interlocutors may ask questions about the relevant part.

There will be two instructors in each class.

In the first stage, the interlocutor welcomes the student and asks the student to introduce himself/herself. (name, age, hometown, department, family, etc.) This portion is not evaluated. It serves merely as a warm-up for the student to prepare him/her for the graded portion.

In the second stage, each student chooses 1 statement/question to state his/her opinion. The student is expected to support his/her opinion by providing relevant examples, explanations and details. The interlocutors may ask questions about the relevant part.
