

Education and Training Policy

- To encourage students to participate in course projects and exchange programs aimed at improving foreign language skills.

This policy and its principles are regularly monitored, evaluated and updated within the framework of our School's quality assurance system. Feedback obtained from implementations, monitoring and evaluation reports, and performance indicators are used for necessary improvements. Through this policy, the School of Foreign Languages undertakes to act in compliance with the Education and Training Policy of Kütahya Dumlupınar University.
