

Environmental Policy

The School of Foreign Languages, in line with the University's general Environmental Policy, adopts as its primary objective the protection of the environment, the efficient and sustainable use of natural resources, and contributing to a healthy and safe living environment for humans and all living beings. In this context, the School adopts the following fundamental objectives and principles as its environmental policy:

- To ensure full compliance with national and international environmental legislation and to consider environmental responsibilities in all institutional activities,

- To contribute to the protection and development of green spaces and to promote sustainable campus practices that support the ecological balance,
- To raise awareness among students and staff regarding environmental responsibility and to strengthen a culture of sustainable living,
- To regularly monitor and evaluate the environmental performance of the School, to carry out continuous improvement activities, and to develop cooperation with internal and external stakeholders.

This policy and its principles are regularly monitored, evaluated and updated within the framework of the School's quality assurance system. Necessary improvements are made in line with feedback obtained from implementations, monitoring and evaluation reports, and performance indicators. Through this policy, the School of Foreign Languages undertakes to act in compliance with the Environmental Policy of Kütahya Dumlupınar University.
