Improvement of Physical Areas in the Campus Environment

- Facilitative attempts in the elevators, stairs, ramps and toilets of the buildings
- Improved access to the hospital, library, canteen, toilets and dining hall

- Easy access to classes

- Preparation for computer-based exams (onscreen keyboard)
- Appointing a certain supervisor during the exam
